Open towel, arrange items on towel, and fold towel sides so as to encase the items. Tie with cord or crochet yarn to keep together and flat. Place these in tote bag or back pack. Fold bag and tie securely so as to lie flat for packing to conference. These will be distributed to those in need throughout South Carolina.
